



Instruction weed wiper +

1. General information

Before using the plant protection product, please read the product manufacturer's instructions for use and application requirements, as well as the applicable legal regulations.

Always wear protective gloves and/or suitable protective clothing.

The devices have been tested with glyphosate.

2. Filling the devices

Mix one part glyphosate with two parts water in a bucket or measuring cup.

Please check the glyphosate manufacturer's instructions regarding the application rate. We recommend carrying out a test on a small area beforehand to determine whether the mixing ratio is optimal!

For filling, it is essential to use a funnel with an opening of at least 100 mm or a measuring cup. Place the rod with the wick pointing downwards in an empty bucket and fill the mixture into the rod. Make sure that no product is spilled.

Screw on the cap. Do not tighten it completely – leave it open by approximately half a turn so that air can enter the rod. Wait a little while until the wick has become fully saturated.

3. Operation

Apply the product to or dab only 3–4 leaves per plant. Do not wet the entire plant.

Only treat dry plants. After treatment, there should be no rain for approximately 6 hours.

During work interruptions, tighten the cap firmly and hold the rod with the wick pointing upwards.

4. End of operation

Tighten the cap firmly. Place a plastic bag over the wick to protect against contact.

Collect any remaining product that can no longer be applied using the rod in a suitable container and dispose of it at a hazardous waste disposal facility. Plant protection products must not be poured into the sewage system.

5. Cleaning

Place the rod with the wick pointing downwards in a bucket and clean it with clean water. The cleaning residues must be disposed of as described in section 4.

If contaminated wicks are cleaned while the devices are still filled, this must also only be done in a container – never hold the wick under running water. Dispose of the residues as described in section 4.
